

Your prescription drug service provider is changing to Express Scripts

Beginning June 1, 2018, prescription drug coverage for NYSNA Benefits Fund participants will be provided through Express Scripts, (ESI) replacing OptumRx as our pharmacy service provider.

- Fund participants will receive new prescription ID cards from ESI, which should be mailed in mid-May, as well as a welcome letter of information with details about filling prescriptions.
- Open refills and prior authorizations will be transferred from OptumRx to ESI for you. (According to New York State law, compound medications and controlled substances will require a new prescription.)
- Maintenance medications in 90-day refills can still be picked up at Walgreens, Duane Reade, and now Rite Aid.
- Non-maintenance prescriptions (with available refills) currently filled at your local retail pharmacy can be refilled without a new script at the same pharmacy.
